This position is funded by the Health Promotion Research Centre (HPRC). The position is available immediately and is for 24 months.

We are seeking to recruit a highly motivated post-doctoral researcher to join the HPRC, which comprises of multidisciplinary team members working in Health Promotion. This is an exciting opportunity to join a vibrant research centre working across several research projects spanning different life stages and topics such as sexual health, mental health and well-being, child and adolescent health, health literacy, nutrition and more. The post-holder will be responsible for embedding and expanding knowledge translation, dissemination and impact activities for research projects in the centre. The post would suit researchers with an interest in knowledge translation and the application of knowledge to practice and policy.

The Health Promotion Research Centre was established in 1990 with support from the Department of Health. The Centre produces high quality research, of national and international significance, that supports the development of best practice and policy in the promotion of health. As the only designated research centre in Ireland dedicated to Health Promotion, the Centre collaborates with regional, national and international agencies, including the EU and WHO, on the development and evaluation of health promotion initiatives. The Centre has an active multidisciplinary research programme and has been designated as a World Health Organization Collaborating Centre since 2009. Salary: Postdoctoral Researcher salary scale €46,305 - €59,063 per annum (subject to the project's funding limitations), and pro rata for shorter and/or part-time contracts.

Job Description:

The successful candidate will

- Undertake and direct knowledge translation, dissemination and impact activities for projects in the HPRC
- Lead and undertake research dissemination and outreach for current research projects, including practice and policy briefs
- Research and develop Knowledge Translation Frameworks and tools for funding applications
- Work with knowledge users, including PPI contributors and service providers, throughout the research process
- Liaise with funders, advisory bodies, and project steering groups
- Document and report on the impact of knowledge translation activities
- Train and support researchers to use Knowledge Translation tools in their work
- Contribute to the development of other projects and grant applications
- Any other duties assigned commensurate with this level of post
- Teaching opportunities may be available to suitable candidates.
